

Haddonfield Crew Club 2008 Swimming Proficiency Test

Note: The HCC will schedule a swim test that is mandatory for all crew members in early February. In past years, the swim test has been given at the Y in Camden. Coaches will announce the exact date of the swim test during winter training.

The sport of rowing poses risks to the participant because most activities occur on, or around water. While we are proactive in our safety measures, risks include, but are not limited to, expected and unexpected entry into an open body of water, such as the Cooper River and the Schuylkill River, collisions with other boats, falling off docks, and other occurrences. A motor boat may take from a few moments to several minutes to reach a boat or rower in need of assistance.

For their own safety, and of others, participants must be competent swimmers. Team members must demonstrate their ability to swim by taking the Haddonfield Crew Club swim test or providing a statement of their swimming ability.
